Before applying :

Our table graphics are designed to perfectly fit Ikea's Lack Table, but may also work with other similarly sized tables or other DIY projects you may have.

- Lay your graphic on a flat surface overnight to straighten out any curl that occurred in the shipping tube.
- Be sure to wipe the surface you are applying to with a dust cloth to

Table Graphic Application Instructions :

Even though you can apply the decal to an already assembled table, it's easiest to apply your decal to before the table is completely assembled.


Place the decal on your table and make sure that it is centered and uniform along each edge of the table. Then apply painter's tape around the edges of one half of the table to securely hold the decal in place as shown. This is an important step because the decals adhesive is very aggressive and you do not want the decal to shift when you apply it.

Separate the backing layer on the loose half and fold back half of the exposed decal. Do NOT crease it or fold too sharply. Cut away the loose portion of the backing layer.


Press your decal to the table surface working from the center and outward to the outer edge.

Smooth the decal as you go along using a squeegee or credit card to gently work out any bubbles if necessary.

Once you have about half the decal secured to your table, you can remove all the painter's tape and proceed with the other half.



To apply the remaining half of the decal, lift up the loose end and peel back all or part of the remaining backing layer.



Press the decal in place to the table, again it's best to work from the center out to the edges.



Continue this process until the decal is applied to the whole table.



Work any bubbles out with a squeegee or credit card.



Congratulations! Your table now has a durable finish that will last for many years and is a fun way to show off your personal style.
